

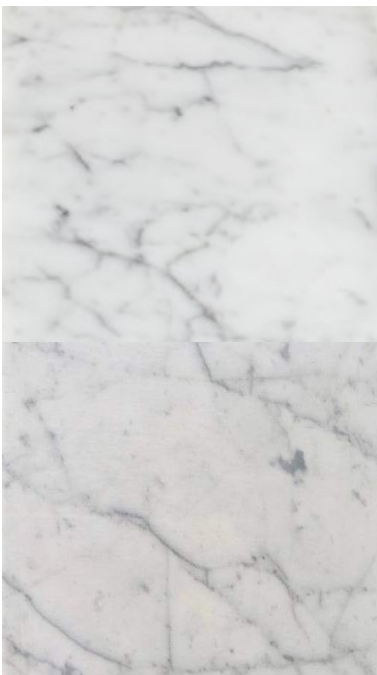
CARRARA STATUARIETTO MARBLE

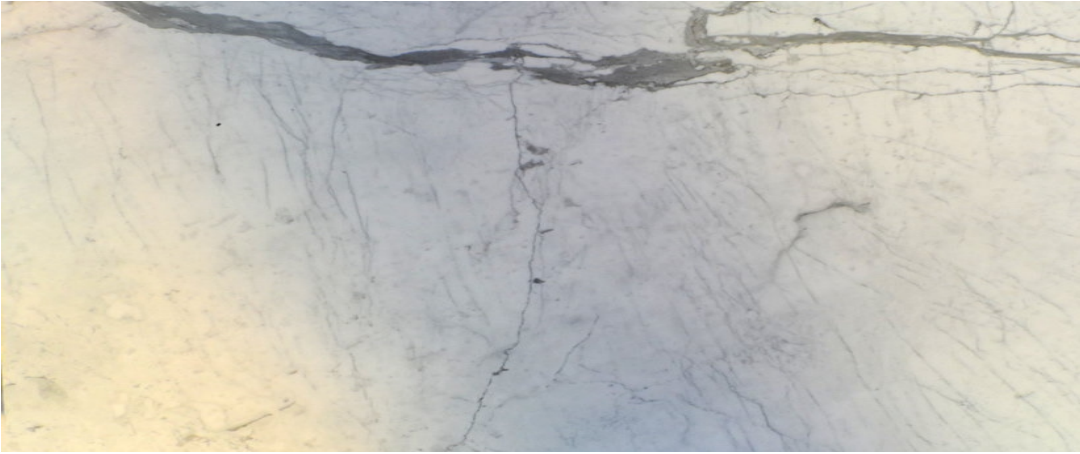
Statuarietto marble is extracted in blocks from the renowned Carrara quarries. Its grain is medium-fine and its texture is characterised by light but concentrated veins in shades of grey that stand out against a milk-white background. This texture and the contrast between grey/milk white make it very suitable for design solutions in modern and exclusive environments.

In its natural form, it can have both "micro-holes", known in jargon as "tarols", and "crystallines", which are to be considered exclusively a characteristic of marble. Since it is a natural product, any visible "imperfections" are actually intrinsic characteristics of the material, which is worked in an artisanal manner with state-of-the-art machinery and polished with natural waxes that tend to respect the very essence of the nature of marble.

For the correct maintenance of the material, it is advisable not to pour acidic liquids such as Vinegar, Lemon, Tea, Coffee, Wine, Oil, Coca Cola. Remove them immediately so that they do not affect the polish.

We recommend very gentle cleaning products without thinners or corrosive chemicals. In the case of a high-gloss finish, the periodic use of specific waxes may be useful to bring out the gloss of the material.
